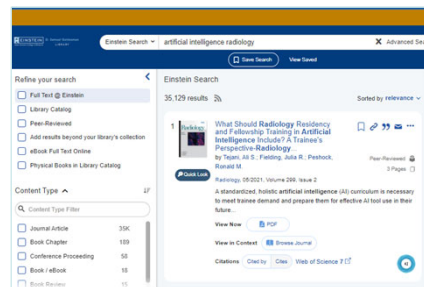

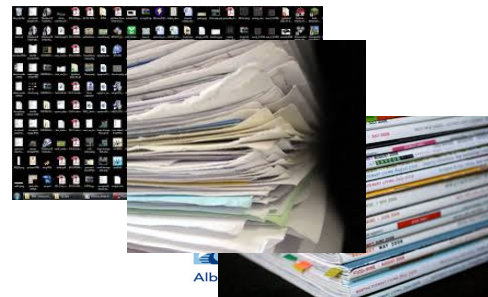

Why use a citation manager?

- Collect & store references & PDFs
- Organize references
 - > *What good is a collection of articles if you can't find anything?*
- Insert references into documents & create bibliographies
 - > Research papers
 - > Grants
 - > CV or resume
- Share references & collaborate

- Desktop citation management software
 - > Windows & Mac
 - > Einstein Library has a site license
 - Download from Library website
 - Install on up to 3 devices
 - > Add-on for MS Word
 - > Sync with EndNote Online
 - iPad app

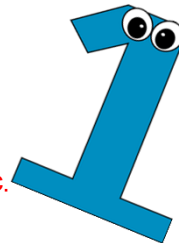

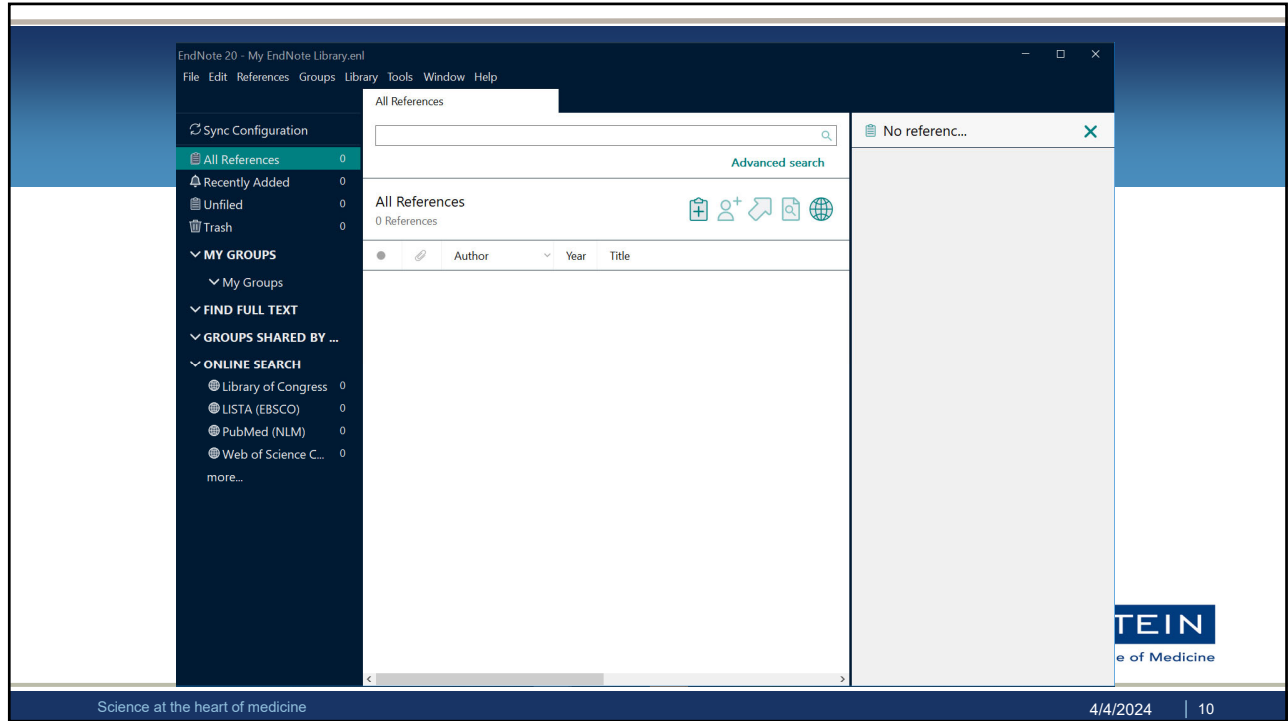

Create a LIBRARY

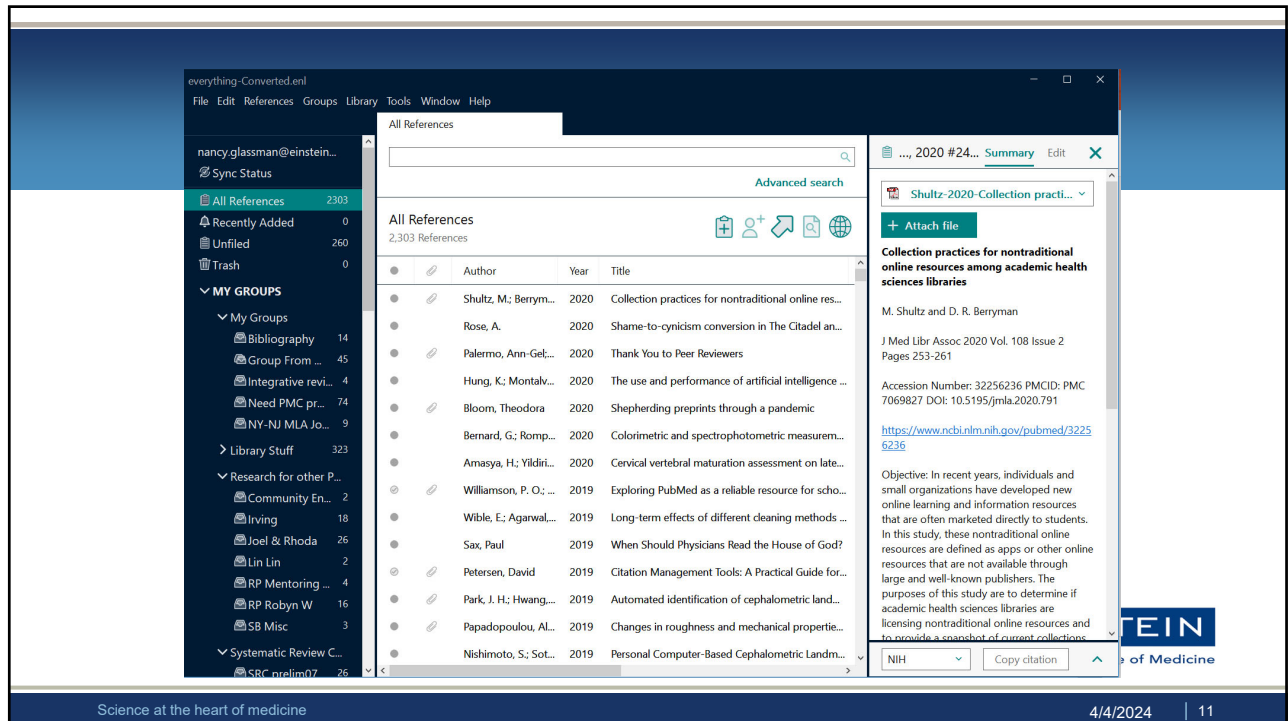
- File / New...

- Useful for capturing a "*known item*"
 - > PubMed
 - > Library Catalogs such as Library of Congress
- Not recommended for in-depth searches
 - > Lacks special search features (filters, etc.)



Duplicates



- Check for duplicate records frequently
- Library > Find Duplicates
- Compares side by side
- Check carefully, sometimes EndNote misses
 - > Edit > Preferences > Duplicates to tweak settings

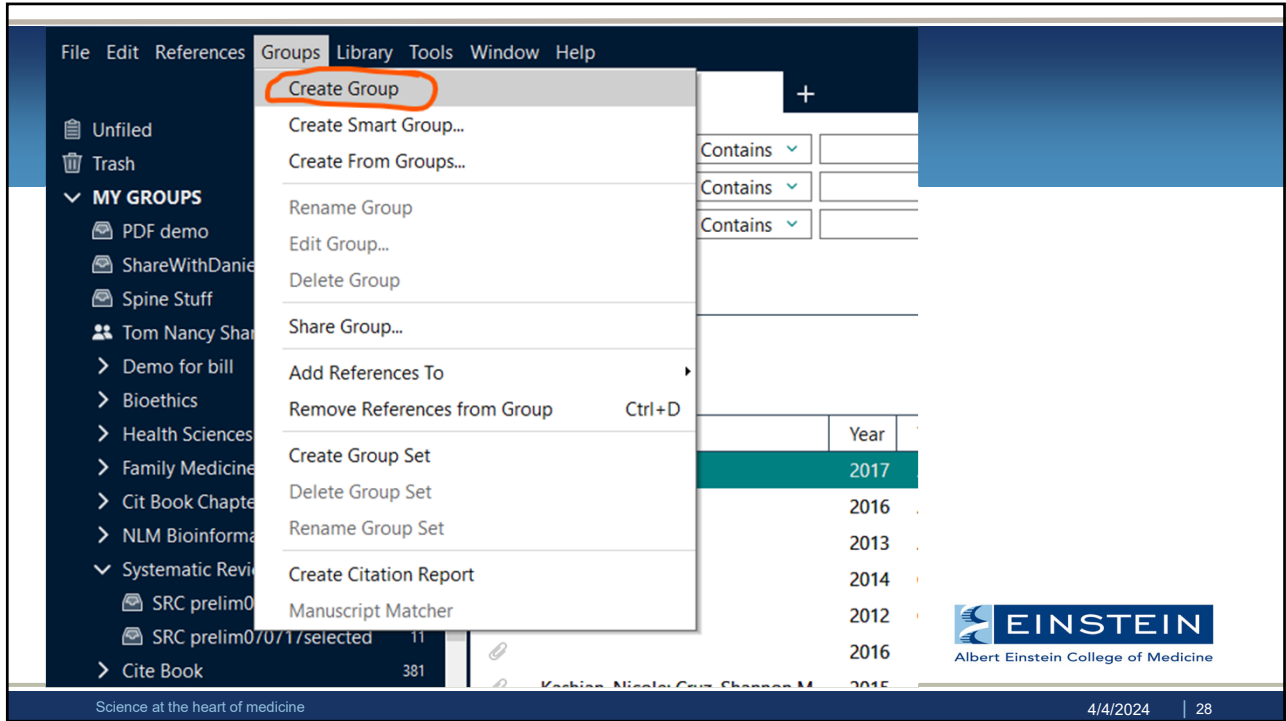

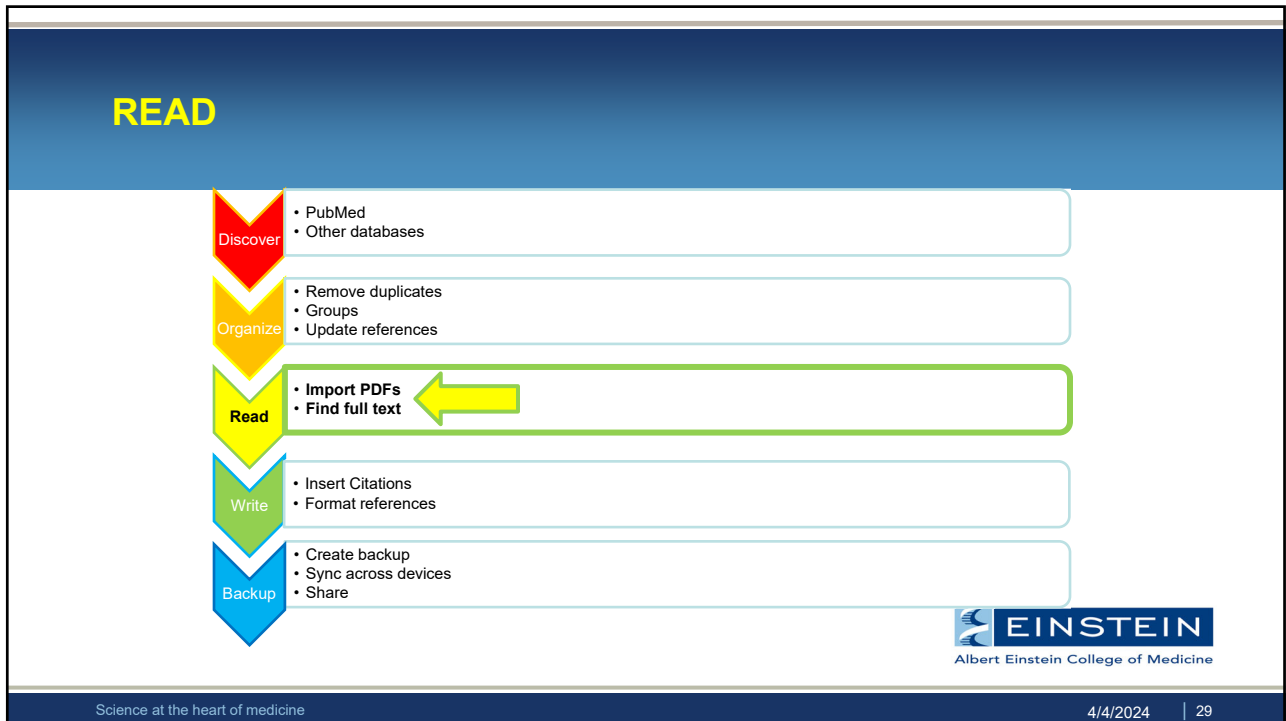

Full Text (PDFs)



1. **Find Full Text** – use when you have references in your library & need full text
 - > References > Find Full Text
2. **Import publisher PDFs** – use when you have PDFs saved on your hard drive (*publisher-supplied PDFs containing DOI information*)
 - > File > Import (file or folder)
 - > Import Option = PDF
3. **Link to PDFs on your computer** – use when options 1 & 2 don't work
 - > References > File Attachments

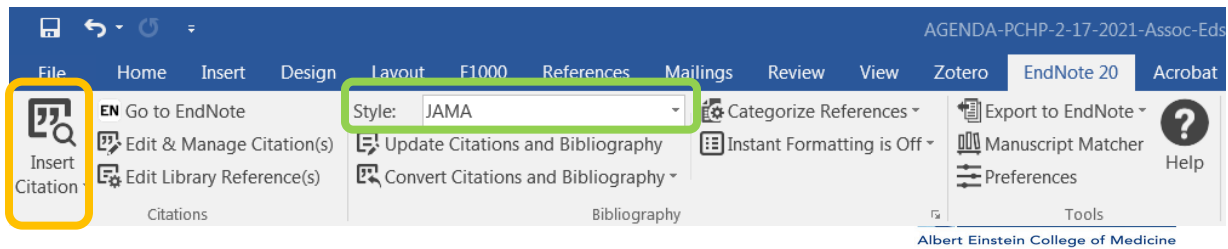

Collaborating on a Paper – tips




- One team member should be responsible for citations
- If all EN users, all can insert citations from their own libraries into the same manuscript
- Export to EndNote > Export Traveling Library
 - > Transfers Word citations to your EN Library
- Alternative – team members insert PMID where in-text citations should be placed. One team member is responsible for citations & adds references to their EN Library and insert into document.

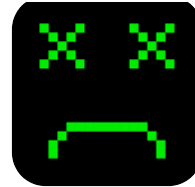
Sharing & Collaborating

- Before you can share you library, you must configure Sync
- Must sync entire library, not individual Groups
- Set read/write access for “shares”

Important Files to Back up

- Backup your EndNote Library file & data folder.
 - > mylibrary.enl
 - > mylibrary.DATA
- Compressed Library feature makes it easy to transfer a Library.
 - > File > Send To > Compressed Library
 - > The file name ends with .enlx
